Get Ready, Get Set, Go Diving

In January it may be hard to imagine going diving in Missouri, but I am headed for Bennet Spring next week to dive, thanks to a new dry suit and a properly service regulator.

Is your equipment ready for this years Missouri dive season? Has your life support system (first, second stage regulator & Alt Air source) been serviced or is it hid away out of site and mind. All scuba regulator systems require annual service and maintenance. With many, it is a warranty requirement. Some brands, such as Scuba Pro, require annual service be performed on their regulators by a certified repair center each year to maintain the life time warranty status. Annual service normally takes a few days, depending on the dive center's back load, availability of parts and time of year.

The price for annual service varies from Dive Center to Dive Center, with the cost to service a first stage running between \$45 and \$60, 2nd stage between \$20 and \$40 and SPG \$10 to \$20. I recommend you ask the Dive Center up front the cost of annual service on your reg system, are the parts covered by the manufacture's warranty, and when will it be completed. Remember to take you warranty card or other documentation as proof of purchase and the receipt from last years annual service. Are they certified and authorized.

Why take a change on missing your first dive this year, especially when it involves you "Life Support System". Don't wait until the Dive Center is busy this spring with classes, Open Water training and equipment rental. Visit your Dive Center of choice now, have your regulator system serviced now and "Get Ready, Get Set, Go Diving".

M/V Sun Dancer II Live-A-Board Palau Thanksgiving 2002

Join SJS aboard the M/V Sun Dancer for a seven night voyage November 22nd to December 1st, 2002 in Palau. We depart Palau on Sunday from the government dock at Malakal Harbor, Koror. Passengers may board the Sun Dancer II any time after 4:00 PM on the day of departure. The boat usually leaves dock between 5:00 and 6:00 PM, though times may vary due to flight schedules. Palau has been described as one of the Seven Underwater Wonders of the World, with 700 species of coral and 1,500 species of fish identified. Palau provides some of the best virgin diving to be found in Micronesia and is ideally suited for the more adventurous diver. Future IDC Courses

PADI Course Director Ernie Miller has scheduled several new Instructor Development Courses for 2001. February 23rd in St. Joseph and April 14th for Scuba Sports in Branson Missouri. Upon completion, candidates will earn the PADI Assistant Instructor (AI) rating and be qualified to set for a PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) examination (IE) conducted by PADI. Duties of the PADI AI include teaching academic sessions, teaching limited confined water skills and surface skill evaluation during Open Water training. AI's may also independently teach Snorkeling, Peak Performance Buoyancy, Discover Scuba, Medic First Aid Equipment Speciality, and the new Bubblemaker program. AI's are one of the most valuable assets of a Dive Training Team. OWSI's are authorized to teach Open Water and Jr. Open Water, Advanced Open Water, Rescue Diver, Divemaster, and Peak Performance Buoyancy. New revised AI & IDC Curriculum

PADI will release the revised IDC curriculum at DEMA in January 2001. Many exciting changes are planned for the IDC. The following lists some of the possible changes being considered by PADI Instructor Development.

- 1. Split the IDC into two components. An Assistance Instructor course three (3) days in length and the Instructor Development Course four (4) days in length. Total length for both remains at seven (7) days.
- 2. Move the 800 yard Mask, Snorkel and Fin swim to the IDC to be evaluated by the Course Director.
- 3. Revise the curriculum to reflect "Prescriptive Teaching" and now cover Open Water, Advanced, Rescue and Diversater as part of the course and IE.
- 4. Upgrade the IDC Staff Instructors to MFA Instructor Trainers. This will require additional training with a Course Director.
- 5. Split the IE into modules, with credit given for modules successfully completed. Candidates would no longer need to re-take the entire IE, just the modules they were unsuccessful. The IE may be extended to reflect the above changes.
- 6. Additional duties and responsibilities for the Assistant Instructors.
