#### Memorial Day Certification Weekend (Open Water and Advanced Open Water)

Join the SJ Scuba Dive Training Crew for a **3-Day** certification weekend at Table Rock Lake and earn you PADI Open Water and Advanced Open Water certification in one fun-filled dive weekend.

Open Water Students will complete three dives on Saturday and one dive on Sunday. Adventures in Diving Students will complete two dives on Sunday and one dive on Monday. Advanced Open Water Students will complete two dives on Sunday and three dives on Monday. Call Ernie by May 1st, 2002 to reserve a spot for the weekend. Open Water Certification is \$95.00, Adventures in Diving is \$100.00 and Advanced Open Water is \$195.00. Take both Open Water and Adventures in Diving for \$150.00 or Open Water and Advanced Open Water for \$225.00. You will need to bring extra money for tank fills, \$5 per tank (3 tanks needed for open water, additional 3 for Advanced Open Water). We recommend a light wetsuit for your open water checkout. Wetsuits can be purchased or rented from various dive centers in our newsletter, and for your convenience, Scuba Sports in Branson is open late Friday nite (call ahead please) and will pick up the wetsuits at the dive site when you are finsished.

This will be a very busy weekend, as we have many students from our fall and spring classes that will be completing their open water dives for certification. Call early to reserve your motel room. The SJ Scuba staff will be staying at the Table Rock Inn (800-234-5890), which is only 1 mile from the dive site. Plan to arrive at the dive site by 7:45 am on Saturday. Remember to bring your log books!

We depart Grand Turk on Saturday from the government dock in Grand Turk. This is an all inclusive luxury dive vacation including Air, Transfers, Port Fees, Meals, 27-Dives and free Alcoholic Drinks. All you provide is the fun!!!!!

Grand Turk, the lower chain of the Turks and Cacios Islands, provides some of the best virgin diving to be found in Caribbean. Aboard M/V Wind Dancer, our 7-day cruise will include diving the Grand Turk, Salt Cay and South Caicos outer islands as we explore the southern and eastern islands of the Turks and Caicos. A brief stop on Salt Cay is planed to revisit the island and Salt Cay Divers.

SJ Scuba has booked the **entire** boat for this annual Thanksgiving trip. Departing on Saturday morning from KCI, we arrive Saturday afternoon in time for a late afternoon departure from Grand Turk.

Space is limited to 20 persons, with several spots already filled from the canceled Palau trip. (Peter Hughes no longer has a boat in Palau during Thanksgiving) A non-refundable deposit (Deposits may be transferred to another person) of \$250.00 per person is due upon sign up, with additional deposits required January 1st, 2003 and May 1st, 2003. Final payment due August 15th, 2003. Estimated cost \$2,350 per person.

### Lost Luggage and your rights as a Passenger

It isn't a matter of asking, it's a matter of law and the law changed two years ago. The compensation cap for baggage lost on Domestic flights prior to January 18, 2000 was \$1,250.00. It has changed to \$2,500.00. For lost luggage lost on international flights, compensation remains unchanged and is subject to the liability limit set by the Warsaw Convention of \$9.07 per pound with a maximum of \$640.00 per bag. The international limit also applies on domestic segments of international trips. Bear in mind that airlines don't automatically pay the full amount of every claim received. They estimate the value of lost possessions, then consider their depreciated value - not the original price or even the replacement cost. To avoid being left with less compensation than your belongings are worth, consider purchasing "Excess Valuation" coverage for the airlines, if it's available. It isn't insurance per say, but it does ratchet up the carrier's potential liability. If the airline's settlement doesn't fully cover your loss, check your homeowner's or renter's police, which sometimes compensates you for losses on the road. Lastly, some credit card companies offer supplemental coverage.
