"Tobago of the West Indies"

November 20th to 27th 2004

SJ Scuba is heading to Tobago in the West Indies for a week of diving and fun. Tobago and Trinidad are located in the southern Caribbean just a short distance from South America. An island Columbus never saw, Tobago has changed hands may times, from Dutch to French to British, back to French and finally becoming a British Crown Colony in 1889. A small island at 30 miles by 7 miles, Tobago is completely covered by mountains and rain forest.

Our all-inclusive package includes RT Air from KCI, Lodging at the Blue Water Inn, 6-days of 3-tank diving with Aqua Marine Dive Ltd. Our meal plan includes Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. Aqua Marine Dive Ltd is a PADI 5-Star dive center and is located on the property of the Blue Water Inn.

The Blue Water Inn has 38 air-conditioned rooms with a balcony or patio and its own distinctive view of Batteaux Bay, Glover's Island and Little Tobago. The Fish Port Restaurant serves local seafood, their specialty.

Divers will encounter Giant Manta Rays, Turtles, Moray Eels, Eagle Rays and over 70 species of coral, including giant brain corals. An overnight stay Friday night in San Juan is planned, giving the group time to shop and see San Juan before continuing on to Tobago Saturday afternoon.

Estimated cost is \$1,950.00 for a diver and \$1,650.00 for a non-diver. Deposit of \$100.00 required to sign up with additional deposits of \$250.00 due July 2003, January 2004 and July 2004. Trip size will be limited to 30 total.

Dominica

Adventure Trip & Digital Underwater Photo Workshop July 3rd to July 10th, 2004

Join SJ Scuba and Ryan Canon in Dominica for the very first "Dominica Digital Underwater Workshop and Seminar" to one of the Caribbean's most remote and pristine locations. Dominica's reefs offer an abundance of fish life, and are some of the healthiest reefs in the world. In addition to diving, Dominica offers many exciting topside attractions, from whale watching to hiking at waterfalls, lakes and a tropical rain forest. One of the many unforgettable underwater attractions will be diving an active volcano. Castle Comfort Lodge and Dive Dominica will be our hosts on this island adventure. The 7-day package includes, RT airfare from Kansas City, 5 days of 2-tank diving, a night dive, breakfast, dinner, and airport transfers.

Divers taking part in the workshop will have use of free demo equipment to "try out the latest and the greatest equipment", but must sign up in advance to ensure availability. Divers who bring a laptop will be able to take part in Photoshop demonstrations on editing and printing. The workshop and seminar is free with a housing/strobe "system" purchased before the trip departs, otherwise a \$200.00 fee will apply. Estimated cost is \$1995 for a diver and \$1,650 for a non-diver. A \$250 deposit to sign up is required, with final payment due March 1st, 2004. Trip size will be limited to 20 divers, so sign up as soon as possible!

Florida July 17-24, 2004 Key Largo Trip was a Blast!

Join SJ Scuba for a return trip to Key Largo for a 7-day package that includes, RT airfare from Kansas City, 10 Water Experiences provided by It's a Dive, which include 2-tank boat dives, parasailing and wave runners with lodging at the Key Largo Marriott. Optional meal plans are available including a discount card for all meals purchased at the Marriott.

Diving the upper keys offers several wrecks to choose from including the recently sunk Spiegel Grove, or the Bentwood, Bibb, Duane, Eagle and City of Washington. Most reef dives average 15-30 foot in depth with average visibility of 50-70 feet. Marine life is everywhere, with nurse sharks, turtles and eagle rays very common.

The US Coast Guard Cutters Bibb and Duane are 327 ft. Treasury Class cutters. The Bibb lies on its side in 130 feet of water with the centerline at about 110 feet. The Duane is upright in 130 feet of water with deck at about 100 feet. The Eagle is a freighter with a length 269 feet and a 40-foot beam. She lies on her starboard side in 130 feet of water. During Hurricane George in 1998, the Eagle broke into 2 pieces.

The USS Spiegel Grove is a 510 ft. landing ship dock lying on its side in 130 feet of water. The centerline of the ship is at about 90 feet. The descent lines are attached to the hull at approximately 50 feet. We do both dives on the Spiegel Grove with a one-hour surface interval, weather and currents permitting.

Estimated cost is \$1295 for a diver and \$895 for a nondiver. A \$250 deposit to sign up is required, with final payment due March 1st, 2004. Trip size will be limited to 20 divers, so sign up as soon as possible!

Grenada June 12-19, 2004 Adventure and Eco Trip

Join SJS in Grenada for a seven-night stay at the Coyaba– Grenada's Premier Resort, June 12th to June 19th. Our trip includes five days of 2-tank morning dives and a night dive with Eco Dive and EcoTrek. Optional 1-tank afternoon dives are available for \$35.00 per dive.

When it comes to fantastic Caribbean Diving, Grenada has it all. Be it shallow or deep, over wrecks, walls or spectacular reefs, in the calm Caribbean Sea, or drifting in swift Atlantic currents surrounded by sharks, Grenada is the place to be. Grenada's extensive, pristine reefs create a dazzling tropical aquarium. Truly an underwater photographer's dream!

Abundant pelagic life includes eagle rays, bull sharks, reef sharks, white-tips and nurse sharks. Manta rays migrate through the area and sea turtles are very common, as Grenada is a major nesting area. The "Spice Island" also offers a fascinating variety of deep and shallow wrecks, including the awe-inspiring 600 foot cruise ship, Bianca C, nicknamed the "Titanic of the Caribbean".

Optional day/afternoon trips on Grenada will be provided by EcoTrek, as the island is equally beautiful above sea level. Jutting volcanic mountains offer breathtaking views of Grenada – lush rainforests, fertile valleys and palm-fringed beaches. Spectacular water features include tidal-fed salt ponds, volcanic crater lakes, mineral hot springs, limpid streams and dramatic water falls, which cascade into crystal-clear pools.

Our 7-day package includes seven nights at Coyaba Resort on the beach, five 2-tank dives (including night dive), use of tanks, weights, belts and breakfast daily. RT air from KCI airport, transfers and all taxes. Divers may choose between an EcoTrek trip on Friday to the largest waterfalls and clear pool and a morning 1-tank dive.


