OWSI's are authorized to teach Open Water and Jr. Open Water, Advanced Open Water, Rescue Diver, Divemaster, and Peak Performance Buoyancy.

#### **Colorado Altitude Diving from Mike Moseman** Morning Ernie,

Thanks for the info. on how to find dive shops and the fun dive. While in Colorado last week was able to do two dives. One with the Coral Reef Scuba in Arvada SW of Denver in their private gravel pit. Swam around the edge at 18 - 22' for 57 min. All went well and it was a great dive with visibility about 10 - 12'. Second dive with Underwater Phantaseas, Lakewood, Co. They have a special dive area in the Aurora, Co. reservoir east of Denver that they sank a old airplane in about 26' of water. Went down to the plane with one of their instructors. He had never been in reservoir and done all his diving in clear ocean water. Left plane and headed for diving platform. I have to say I did better with my Boy Scout compass than he did with his. I found the platform for us. Ernie, I did learn the lesson the hard way on going up and down slowly along with equalizing both ears. After leave platform to head in didn't equalized left ear completely and at 48' it really hurt and kind of popped. It's still stuffed up and a little sore. On way in Steve ran out of air and I got to share mine with him to surface. I still had 800 lbs left. It is amazing how fast it goes the deeper you go. All in all it was interesting and a good learning experience. Both times the shops were doing open water classes. I really developed an even greater appreciation for the professional way you ran our class, the organization, the involvement and attitude of the sub instructors and the way you instructed us. They covered the information but I think we all got more out of it & had a better experience.

So fare I have manage two night dives and two altitude dives for a total of 5 plus hr under water and still looking forward to the fun weekend. Thank again. *Mike Moseman*
